The Trust expects each of the Academies to provide a Landau Forte style of education which is distinctive, high quality and critically releases the potential of each student, enabling them both individually and collectively to be the best that they can be. Whilst the Academies each have their individual specialisms, the expectation of high standards of learning, teaching, attainment, achievement and student care are common.

At Landau Forte, our basic expectation is that every student makes at least good progress in their studies. The continuous academic development of every learner is central to our wish for young people to access the best that higher education, training and employment can offer.

It is intended that each Academy serves the wider community, providing opportunities for adult education and use of facilities for teams, clubs, societies and community groups.



## UNIQUE STUDENT EXPERIENCE

We have our own distinctive culture and ethos, the cornerstone of which is the high quality pastoral care all our students experience. We are a large school with a small school feel. We know our students as individuals and understand their strengths and areas for development. The vertical tutoring system and the consistency of the same personal tutor during a young person's time at the College means that positive, reassuring relationships are built between the student, peers, the tutor and parents and carers.

We aim to enrich our students' learning experiences by ensuring they all have the opportunity to immerse themselves in activities that they may not ordinarily have access to. Such opportunities can only further develop our young people. In today's competitive society, we want to prepare Landau Forte College students to be able to confidently compete with the top graduates in the UK and beyond.

Landau Forte College is proud to be different from other academies and schools and part of that difference is reflected in our established partnerships with business and industry, which bring the world of work securely into the educational experience. Our students have opportunities to complete meaningful periods of work experience and have access to high quality independent information, advice and guidance in relation to careers education.

Students are offered the opportunity to participate in a wide range of residential and day visits to further enrich their curriculum.

## OUR CURRICULUM

Our curriculum is constantly reviewed and developed so it best caters to the needs of all our students.

Students are able to access a wide range of academic and vocational qualifications.

There is a clear emphasis on the core subjects of mathematics and English. The development of highly literate and numerate students is of vital importance. At Key Stage 3 students all study mathematics, English, science, history, geography, religion philosophy and ethics, Spanish, German, physical education, a range of technology subjects, performing arts and computing. The Key Stage 3 curriculum is complemented by a comprehensive personal, social, health and economic education package which supports our young people in developing the skills they need to grow up as healthy individuals who can confidently make informed decisions about their lives. Careers education is embedded into the curriculum throughout all key stages.

At Key Stage 4 students study a core programme of mathematics, English and the sciences, complemented with a comprehensive personal, social, health and economic education package and physical education. They then select four further subjects to study at GCSE or vocational level from a wide range selection of challenging and exciting subjects.

## SIXTH FORM EDUCATION AT LANDAU FORTE COLLEGE

Our sixth formers have the opportunity to follow pathways tailored to their strengths and interests, including A-level, AS level, BTEC and Cambridge National qualifications. All of the different pathways available are challenging and ambitious and reflect the needs of the employment market locally, nationally and globally.

At Key Stage 5 students can follow a programme to support progression into higher education or employment and training. A students' main studies will be enhanced with a core programme which includes personal, social, health and economic education, work related learning and work experience opportunities, robust careers education and information, advice and guidance. They may also have the opportunity to study the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), AS level general studies or critical thinking.

Sixth formers are supported by committed and dedicated tutors who ensure they play a key role in the life of the College. They are expected to act as role models for the other young people in the College and are able to support younger students academically and pastorally through numeracy and literacy mentoring, peer mentoring and through the vertical tutoring system. There are engaging and exciting enrichment opportunities for Sixth Form students to participate in. These are vast and wide ranging including the Duke of Edinburgh, the Student Leadership Team, International Visits such as World Challenge, sporting activities, visits to Universities and employers.

All sixth form students participate in a fantastic careers programme which ensures that they are well informed and prepared for their next steps after completion of Sixth Form education, whether this is university, an apprenticeship or employment. We have many exciting visits from business leaders and successful alumni that help our Sixth Form students shape their thinking about further education and future careers.

## AN INCLUSIVE COLLEGE

Landau Forte College is proud of its superb track record of inclusion for all. The personalised support we provide to our students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) enables them to develop as independent and confident learners who play a full and important role in the life of the College.

We have a dedicated suite of rooms as the base for our inclusion team which includes the Learning Support Unit and the Support Centre. The area provides high quality, bespoke support for young people with complex needs. We passionately believe that SEND should not prevent a young person accessing mainstream education. Our team of highly skilled Learning Support Assistants provide high quality, in session support across all curriculum areas.

For students to be successful learners it is vital that they can read and comprehend the work being studied. We provide a variety of one to one and small group interventions for our students whose reading age falls below their chronological age.





## THE IMPORTANCE OF LITERACY AT LFCD

We are committed to improving the literacy skills of all our students and place great emphasis on promoting the importance of reading for pleasure. Our well-resourced Information Centre ensures all students have access to a wide range of high quality, challenging literature. We also ask all that our parents and carers encourage their sons and daughters to read regularly and aid vocabulary development by engaging their children in discussions about the books they are currently reading.
