SafeSearch can help you block inappropriate or explicit images from your Google Search results. The SafeSearch filter isn't 100% accurate, but it helps you avoid most adult content.


## What do I need?

A Google account (Email address and Password)


## Step-By-Step

SafeSearch can be easily turned on for a single use, but for it to permanently stay on you will need to lock SafeSearch.


- 1 Go to [google.co.uk](https://www.google.co.uk), select the 'Settings' tab and click on 'Search settings'.




- Find the 'SafeSearch Filters' section and check the 'Filter explicit results' box, then click on 'Lock SafeSearch'.



- When prompted sign into your Google account. If you haven't got an account click the 'Create an account' link.



- Finally, to confirm, click the 'Lock SafeSearch' button.



You will need to do this on each browser that you use or if you have multiple Google accounts.
