The Little Princess Trust

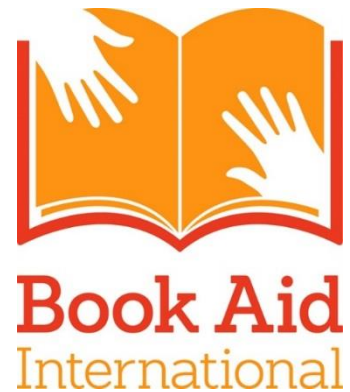
