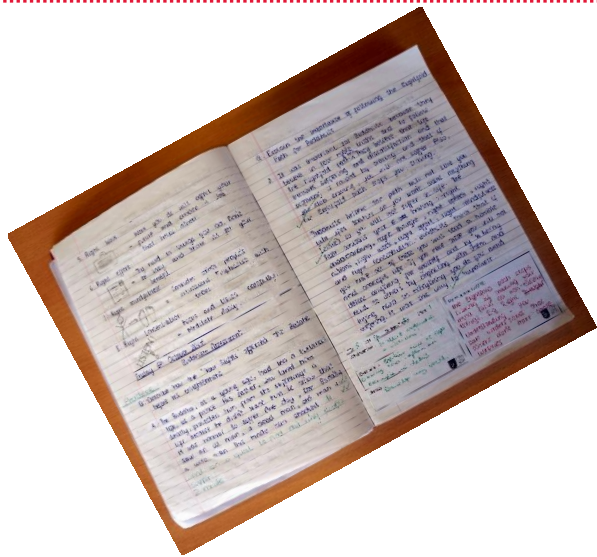
## What Went Well
